Dear Brechtje van de Moosdijk,

The Dutch Prosecution Office usually does not comment on ongoing investigations. However, for sake of transparency and informing the public please answer following questions:

- 1) Is the [letter from Mr. Westerbeke](#) dated August 30 2019 that was leaked by Ukrainian website [thebabel](#) authentic?
- 2) [NRC claims](#) to have established the letter is authentic. Did the Joint Investigation Team or Dutch OM confirm authenticity of the letter to NRC?
- 3) Is Vladimir Tsemakh considered a witness or suspect by the Joint Investigation Team?
- 4) If Mr. Tsemakh declares he is willing to be further interviewed or interrogated in Russia or Ukraine, is the Joint Investigation Team going to accept this condition?
- 5) Bellingcat member 'Daniel Romein' (alias) [tweeted](#): "the person who very likely shot MH17 out of the sky is named Sergey Pozdnyakov, living in Kursk, Russia."

Is Sergey Pozdnyakov regarded a suspect by the Joint Investigation Team?
